New Braunfels Public Library Offers New Wireless Printing Services

New Braunfels, TX – The New Braunfels Public Library has begun offering wireless printing for members of the community. Wireless printing allows citizens to print at the library from any offsite computer, smartphone, or tablet.

To print from a smartphone or tablet only the downloading of the “PrinterOn” app is required. Wireless printing can also be accomplished from computers by visiting <http://www.printeron.net/nbpl/mainlibrary>. Once the process has been completed and delivery confirmed, documents may then be printed out at the public printer in the main library branch at the cost of 10¢ per black and white page, and 50¢ per color page.

This new printing resource allows for printing without transferring files from a flash drive to a library computer, or requiring citizens to e-mail files to themselves in order to print. Printing from anywhere inside the library can also be accomplished from a laptop, smartphone, or tablet this way. Community members are able to send print jobs of almost any kind, from almost any device, from anywhere there's an Internet connection, and then pick them up later at the library. Prints will only be available for 24 hours after being sent.

“We’re absolutely thrilled to be able to give members of our community the convenience and ease of being able to print from most locations and devices, and then retrieving their prints at our library,” said Library Director Gretchen Pruett. “This is a cutting edge resource the library is offering, and is just one of many ways that the New Braunfels Public Library continues to evolve and adapt to the changing needs of a fast-paced world.”
