Fischer Park Awarded Bring Back the Monarchs to Texas Garden Grant

New Braunfels, Texas – The City of New Braunfels Parks and Recreation Department is pleased to announce it has received the Spring 2018 Bring Back the Monarch to Texas Garden Grant from the Native Plant Society of Texas for its Butterfly Garden in Fischer Park.

The Fischer Park Butterfly Garden was selected based on strong evidence of gardening knowledge and skills, good planning, a strong mix of nectar plants for the region, an appropriate selection of native milkweeds for the region, overall design and layout, maintenance plans, public accessibility, overall usefulness to Monarchs, plans for outreach and education use, and more.
