Kristi Aday Named Comal County Habitat for Humanity Board President

New Braunfels, TX – Assistant City Manager Kristi Aday was recently elected President of the Board of Directors of the Habitat for Humanity chapter servicing Comal County. The organization provides housing at an affordable price at less than half of the national average. Affiliated with the local chapter for the past three years, Aday has also volunteered her time with other chapters for a number of years prior to settling in New Braunfels.

“Comal County Habitat is carrying-out a much-needed service that will only grow in importance as housing prices continue to rise,” Ms. Aday said. “Their vision is a world where everyone has a decent place to live, and the social need for this initiative is significant. We utilize local resources, and the hard work of the future homeowners and volunteers, to provide safe and affordable housing to low-income families.”

Comal County Habitat for Humanity was incorporated in the state of Texas as a non-profit corporation in 1993. It is a local affiliate of Habitat for Humanity International.

The Comal County chapter has completed 43 homes as of summer of 2018 - all with donated funds, labor and materials. Habitat homes are not subsidized homes or promoted under any federal program. Comal County Habitat for Humanity initially holds the mortgages for completed homes and all homeowners provide a down-payment and pay a no-interest loan to Habitat for their new dwelling.

“The community is answering the needs of the less fortunate in donating land, building materials and funds,” Aday added. “New homeowners and community members alike have the opportunity to embrace volunteerism by building with Habitat for Humanity. I am honored to serve as President of this important community resource and look forward to fulfilling this leadership role while working with the board, volunteers and community as part of this amazing organization.”
